## Helping you report rape and abuse

Eaves is launching a new sexual violence service in Lambeth, with support from Lambeth Borough Council.

Eaves understands that it can be hard for women to report rape and abuse to the police, and even harder to go through a court case. That's why we've appointed a new Independent Sexual Violence Advocate (ISVA).

Our ISVA is there to help any woman who has been raped, sexual assaulted or sexually abused, at any time in her life. She can also be particularly helpful for women who are considering reporting attacks or who are going to court.



Eaves' ISVA is available to support women in Lambeth in the following ways:

- Talking to police, courts or witness services on a woman's behalf;
- Accompanying women to appointments;
- Helping women develop coping strategies to deal with their experiences;
- Offering support at court and through court cases; and
- Helping women to access other services, such as benefits, housing, training and/or education.
